8:30 - 9:00 Registration sign in. Late entries may be charged an extra \$10 and will be placed at back of the grid for all preliminary heats & qualifying unless prior arrangements are made. Pre-technical self-declaration to be submitted with registration.

9:30 AM Race Director Opens track for practice: first class of day on track Practice sessions of 5 Minutes.
