How does Try A Kart Work?

All you need is a pair of running shoes & enthusiasm; the CKRC provides the rest: kart, helmet, race suit, rib vest, gloves & instruction.

You will spend the 1st hour in the classroom learning about karts, the track, driving technique and the flags used on the track. You will then be on track for 3 ten-minute sessions.

The 1st two sessions will have you learning the lines behind a lead/follow driver. If you have mastered the skills necessary, you will be let loose for the 3rd session, allowing you to explore your driving talents.

Although 10 minutes in a kart doesn't sound like much, your body will tell you otherwise!

Cost:

\$105 – Cadet/Jr/Sr ages 8-75

Additional Information

The Try A Kart program is NOT a race school.

Registration is done through MotorsportReg. If this is your 1st time using MotorsportReg, you will need to create an account to proceed with your payment. Class sizes are limited, so please reserve your spot early.

Please note: No refunds will be given. Only credits to re-schedule on another date will be given if the participant cancels with a minimum 24 hours' notice. In the event of a rain-out, we will reschedule on one of our Rain Dates, as close as possible to the date of the original event.

How to get to our Track

The Calgary Kart Racing Club's Strathmore Motorsports Park is located approximately 1.5 km east of George Freeman Trail (the most eastern set of stop lights), and approximately 1.0 km south of Hwy #1 on Range Road 250. Range Road 250 is at the top of the hill as you leave Strathmore, and is easy to miss.

Please be courteous to our neighbors and do not exceed 30 km/hr on Range Road 250. Park near the white Atco building, but ensure there is an open lane for the club ambulance. Proceed to the blue shack to complete registration 15 minutes before your session is to begin.
