Terms and Conditions

This is not a drop off camp, parents and mechanics are required to supervise their drivers and children during the entire camp. If children are going to be dropped off, arrangements must be made and is outside of the CKRC responsibility.

The CKRC will not be responsible for children left unattended.

Lunch is provided for the driver and mechanic only. Water will also be provided. Due to the time constraints, special meal requests may not be honored. If you have special dietary concerns, please make your own arrangements.

All participants must be CKRC members in good standing to be eligible for the \$200 fee. Preference will be given to CKRC members first. Non-members and out of town drivers will be placed on a waiting list with no guarantee of participation.

Payment must be made in full prior to attending the camp. Registration will be set up through [Motorsportsreg.com](https://motorsportsreg.com) (date will be announced).

Karting is an outdoor activity, please be prepared for any potential weather.

The CKRC Code of Conduct will apply. Abuse of organizing volunteers and other participants will not be tolerated and will likely result in expulsion for the remainder of the event. In addition, further sanctions may be placed on the driver through the CKRC executive.

No refunds will be given for expulsions, inclement weather, etc.

All karts and equipment must meet the minimum safety requirements before being allowed on track. Each driver is responsible for providing their own equipment, kart, fuel and other consumables.

The parental waiver with BOTH parents' signatures must be on file with the CKRC as a condition of acceptance into the camp.

The camp will be subject to cancellation if insufficient numbers. Registered participants will be notified as soon as possible.
