8:00 AM Gates Open

8:30 - 9:00 Registration. Late entries may be charged an extra \$10 and will be placed at back of the grid for all preliminary heats & qualifying unless prior arrangements are made. Pre-technical self-declaration to be submitted with registration.

8:45 - 0900 Marshall's, Grid Marshall's & Medic's briefing by Race Director

0900- 0915 Drivers briefing (All Drivers) (See CKRC Sup Regs 10.2)

0915- 0920 Incident Marshall's briefing (Junior 1 CADET class only)

9:30 AM Race Director Opens track for practice: first class of day on track Practice sessions of 5 Minutes

1. **The Event** :- There will be Un-timed Practice (5 min), Qualifying (6 min), Pre Final (10 laps) and Final (12 laps)
