Date: Saturday October 8th 2022

Race day Schedule: Gates open at 8:00AM

The following schedule may be delayed or changed if the weather is too cold to start the Juniors.

Registration ALL classes through motorsportreg.com

Warm Up

9:00 Driver Meeting

9.30 Junior 1 Warm Up (20 Mins)

10 to 10.20 Junior Two Warm Up (20 Mins)

10.30 to 11.00 Senior Warm Up (30 Mins)

Junior One Enduro

11.00 to 11.45 3/4 HOUR Straight race no pit stops required

Start from the Pre Grid single file 1 warm up lap in single file then straight to the start

Junior 2 Enduro

12.00 – 1pm 1 HOUR Straight Race

Start from the Pre Grid single file 1 warm up lap in single file then straight to the start

1.00 – 1.30 Officials lunch

1.00 PM Seniors should assemble on the Pre Grid in Pea Pick start order in a straight line.

Seniors Enduro

Start from the Pre Grid single file 2 warm up laps in single file then straight to the start to form up

2 LAP WARM UP IN GRID ORDER NO OVERTAKING. Form up in one diagonal line for the Le Mans start from West (P1) to East JUST BEHIND THE START LINE LOOP (E) on the start finish straight. Karts are to be on the Southern side of the main straight Drivers will sprint across the track from the North to the South.

Teams should position themselves on the Pre Grid for the start during the Officials lunch break.)

Pit Spaces may be set up during the Lunch break.

1:35 to 4:35 Enduro (3 Hours)

Marshaling will be done via the Pixel light system

Green lights will be shown throughout the race and will be changed by Race Control when required.

Race Format:

- We will run the track **clockwise**.
- Track starting position will be by pea pick (Shifters at back) AND Pit location will be on first come basis.
- STARTS: - All karts will be placed on the track in Echelon position pointing up track Southern edge of track. One assistant per kart is allowed to stand by to assist in starting. Drivers will be positioned across the track from their Kart. On start signal drivers will run to their Karts and **once seated** their assistant may start the Engine.
- Pit area will be the area to the South side of PIT IN lane. Pits are to be set up on the grassed area along the fence line. NO EQUIPMENT TO BE PLACED ON THE PAVEMENT.
- When entering pits, drivers may drive to their Pit Box and stop on the **LEFT** side of the marked lane divider (Painted Line) it is mandatory to shut off the engine once in your box if you intend to service your kart.
- **Drivers may not be sat in the Kart during refuelling. All teams must have a fire extinguisher to hand.**
- When returning to the track all Karts are to safely pull out of their box and move across to the **RIGHT** of the lane divider (Painted line) and drive slowly back out onto the circuit. UNSAFE RELEASE WILL BE PENALIZED.
- Drivers leaving the circuit are to indicate that they are leaving the circuit by raising their arm and staying over to the right of the circuit at the exit blend line. **Blend lines MUST be obeyed.**

Classes:

Jr 1 Enduro:

1. Junior 1: LO206 as per 2021 club rules Including Tires (ONLY LO206) **240 lbs**

Junior 2 Enduro:

1. Junior 2: Four stroke as per 2021 club rules including Tires (ONLY LO206) **300 lbs**
2. Junior 2: Rotax Junior as per 2021 club rules including Tires **320 lbs**

Senior Enduro

1. Senior Four Stroke: Any ASN or Calgary approved 4 stroke engine configurations. (See .10) - average age of drivers under 35 years old.
2. Masters Four Stroke: Any ASN or Calgary approved 4 stroke engine configurations. (See .10)- average age of drivers over 35 years old.
3. Senior Two Stroke: Any ASN or Calgary approved 2 Stroke engine configurations. (See .10) - average age of drivers under 35 years old.
4. Masters Two Stroke: Any ASN or Calgary approved 2 Stroke engine configurations. (See .10) - average age of drivers over 35 years old.
5. Shifter or motors above 40 hp
6. Senior/Masters 4 stroke Senior/Masters 2 Stroke and Shifter. No Weight restriction and Tires are Open.

Notes:

1. ONE KART PER TEAM. Maximum of 4 drivers per team.... **they ALL must be registered.**
2. All kart safety rules apply. Tech forms must be completed.
3. Team managers are required to ensure all their drivers are competent in the kart and able to keep a decent speed and know the correct racing lines they are also to know what the light colours mean (Rookie School Package) <https://link.ckrc.com/rookiecourse...> It is recommended that they attain a minimum of 100 laps prior to the event. (Practice for the week before is free)
4. Fuel and Oil rules do apply!!! Chain oilers are allowed for this event with a maximum capacity of 8 oz as stated in CKRC supplemental regulations.
5. Karts must have engine **switched off and driver out** of the kart before refuelling.
6. Scales will be used for ALL Junior Classes.
7. A compatible fire extinguisher for fighting flammable liquid fires must be to hand during refuelling.
8. Teams may be requested by the Race Director to provide one volunteer race staff member per team for a period of the race to ensure sufficient corner marshalling if required.

9. Tires are Open that is no specific type / compound / manufacturer nor maximum limit to number of tires used for Senior Enduro. **ALL Junior classes must be ran using class regulation tires.**
10. Senior engines must appear stock from a viewing distance of 5 Meters, only one gas tank per Kart. Any 4-stroke engine is allowed; any 2-stroke engine is allowed.
11. Medicals are not required however by registering to race, all participants attest that they would pass an ASN medical examination if taken and are of sufficient health to be able to compete in this event.
12. The winners of each Enduro class will be deemed to be the kart that has completed the greatest number of laps in the time allocated in their class. Each subsequent position will be taken on total laps completed after the winner has been declared in descending order. Once checkered flag is shown to a driver scoring stops.
13. Recovery of karts. With official permission one mechanic may take a kart stand onto the grass beside the track to assist in recovery of a broke down kart, broken down karts and kart stands may not be pushed back on the asphalt
14. Rookie drivers (those who have competed in three races or less) must have an X clearly taped in contrasting colours on the back of their helmets (not the karts license plate). Experienced drivers (non-rookie) are not permitted to enter the track with a X on their helmet
15. Electronic Pit to driver communication is NOT allowed. Communication via Pit board is allowed.
16. **This is a fun race and the highest on track safety should be applied (no do or die manoeuvres) the Race Directors / Deputy Race Directors penalties and decisions are final and not subject to protests or appeals.**

Entry Fees:

Junior 1 \$75.00 per Kart/Team

Junior 2 \$100 Per Kart/Team

Seniors \$ 150.00 per Kart/ Team

Non CKRC Member fee \$50 / Driver

At least one member of a team must be a CKRC Member or a full racing member of an affiliated Kart Club – ie: EDKRA. No additional fees for Affiliated Kart Club members.

Non ASN Club members may practice FREE of charge with their team for the week leading up to the Enduro They must register via Motorsportreg.com and this registration is good for the whole week.
