Group Running Order: - Will be as shown on the Running Order pages following.

Lunch break will be at 12 and will start at the closest to any race finish around that time. This will mean that we may well start the pre finals of some classes before lunch break.

Senior Open. Any Senior Open will run within the class which matches either Horsepower / Speed / or Engine Cycle.

Points will be awarded in respected finishing places per group. Trophy Presentation will take place at the end of the day 15 minutes after the posting of the last race results and after any protests or judicial matters have been dealt with.
